

CRC CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ALL EVENTS RUN UNDER BHS RULES FOR RIDING CLUBS 2023, INCLUDING COVID19 GUIDELINES. ALL ENTRIES ACCEPTED SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- 1. The judge's decision in every case is final and not open to debate.
- 2. Horses and ponies must not be left unattended at any time, including when secured to the outside of horseboxes or trailers.
- 3. All riders must wear the current PAS015 or equivalent standard hat with chinstrap fastened when mounted, even if not competing.
- All hats must have a flexible peak when jumping solid fences. No camera's/GoPro's allowed.
- A body protector is obligatory in all Hunter Trials and Eventers Challenge competitions.
 A BETA Level 3 body protector displaying a Blue 2018 Label must be worn in these competitions.
- 6. Competitors must clear up their rubbish, manure and leftover hay and not leave anything on the show ground.
- 7. No liability will be accepted for anything which may happen to competitors, spectators, their property, servants or horses and ponies in connection with, or arising out of these events.
- 8. No entry fee will be refunded unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced before the relevant class or within seven days after the event.
- 9. Objections must be made in writing, to the show secretary within 15 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a deposit of twenty pounds which is refundable if the objection is sustained.
- 10. All ridden horses and ponies must be a minimum of 4 vrs old.
- 11. No horse or pony may be entered for more than 3 jumping classes in any one day.
- 12. The club reserves the right to refuse admission to events at its discretion.
- 13. Competitors are reminded that the welfare of their horse /pony is paramount.
- 14. CRC reserve the right to deduct £1. per entry should a show be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances beyond our control. This will be for administrative purposes.
- 15. All dogs must be kept on a short lead.
- 16. Stallions are welcome but must be bitted and handled by a responsible adult at all times.
- 17. Any horse acting in a dangerous or unruly manner will be required to leave the show ground and will forfeit any entry monies.
- 18. Any person acting in an unruly or offensive manner will be required to leave the show ground and will forfeit any entry monies.
- 19. Unless in the warm up or competition areas, horses must walk only on showground.

EVENTERS CHALLENGE

This competition will be run over the all weather jumping arena and the cross country course.

Class 1, the mini class, show jumping will be in the all weather then onto a grass arena where there will be a course of natural fences.

All other classes, riders will complete the showjumping section, which will not be timed, but faults will count. Riders exit the arena and make their way immediately to the cross country start, where they will be set off for the second phase. This phase will be timed, with both sections to count to final placings. There will be at least 16 jumping efforts in all classes.

Cross country attire to be worn in both phases, studs may be worn in the arena.

Parking will be in the back fields for this event.

RULES FOR TOP SCORE

- The course will consist of 12 obstacles which can be jumped in any order
- Fences 1 to 11 will be built to differing heights and each will carry a points value ranging from 20 to 120. The 12th fence will be a joker fence worth 200 points
- Time allowed is 45 seconds and the time starts when the competitor crosses the start line
- The competitor scores the number of points allotted to each obstacle, provided it is jumped clear. No points are scored for an obstacle knocked down
- An obstacle which is knocked down or displaced for any reason is not rebuilt. This includes the displacement of a lower element in the same vertical plane
- Each obstacle may be jumped twice to score. Jumping, voluntarily or otherwise, an obstacle for the third or subsequent time, or jumping or passing through an obstacle already knocked down or displaced, including the displacement of a lower element, does not incur elimination but scores no points
- Disobediences are not penalised since they decrease the time available in which to score. Following a disobedience, a competitor may either attempt the same obstacle again or proceed to the next obstacle of his choice. A second or subsequent disobedience does not incur elimination but the Judge may retire a competitor if it becomes apparent that repeated disobediences have destroyed all chance of the competitor featuring in the prize list
- The bell is rung as soon as the time allowed is reached. The
 competitor must then cross the finishing line in either direction to
 allow their time to be recorded. If they do not cross the finishing
 line, they are placed last of the competitors with the same number
 of points
- The number of points allotted to the last obstacle jumped clear will be included in the competitor's score provided the horse has already started to take off at the moment when the time allowed is reached
- Jumping an additional obstacle or obstacles after the bell has been rung is not penalised
- The Joker may be jumped twice to score. If jumped clear, 200 points are added to the score, but if the Joker is knocked down, 200 points are deducted from the score
- In the event of equality of points, time decides


